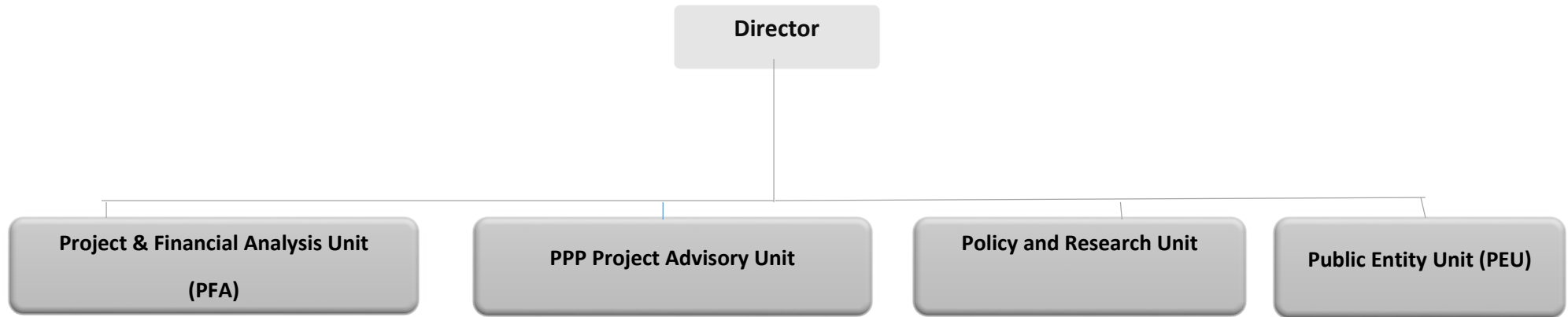


## Organogram



- Provide investment guidelines, project development and preliminary screening and formal project appraisal as well as the selection of projects and budgeting for funding;
- Serve as “gatekeeper” for all projects including PPPs;
- Advise on financing options
- Coordination with Public Investment Agencies and Divisions (NDPC, Budget, Debt Management)
- Sensitisation of MDAs on PIM Guidelines;
- Monitor implementation of all projects including PPPs;
- Infrastructure Database Management
- Secretariat for PPP Approval Committee/ PIP Working Group

- Identification of PPP projects with stakeholders;
- Serve as a centre of expertise and assist Contracting Authorities (CAs) in reaching financial close of "PPP" projects;
- Advise on resolving any obstacles to the wide use of PPP;
