Technology management and operation approaches appear to be employed on a case-by-case basis as observed in the rollout of the Team Mate audit application which did not meet the end to end business requirements for the Agency. The Information Communication Technology (ICT) unit at the Agency is responsible for monitoring and maintaining information technology systems and services for IAA operations.
