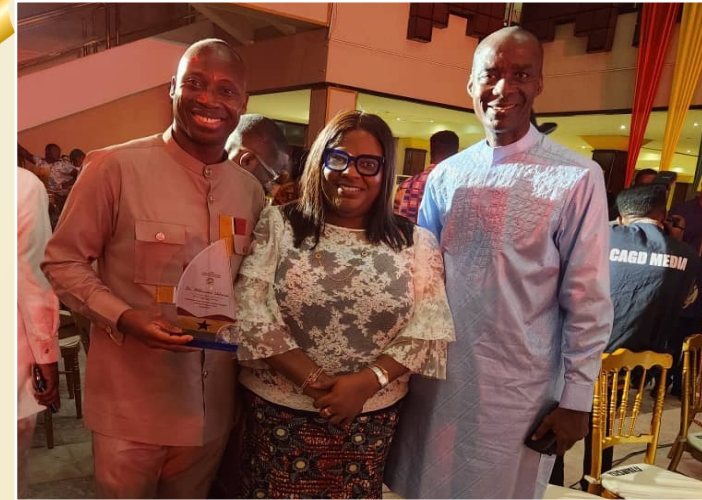


# AWARDS NIGHT
